

Activity

Areport vas presented requesting support for furting provided by Welsh Government to enable counsist to provide support under a discretionary scheme to help households in medical assistance with their living costs. The Committee varies also deduction to the committee vas also asked to support the Council in making a contribution of £100 kto the Baerau Gwent Foodbark and £10 kto Citizens Advice Bueau (CAB).

Outcome

The committee supported the £150 payment to eligible households and also the £30 kcontribution to CAB, however, the committee recommended an amendment to the \$50 km, that £30 kbe provided to BGF cochankas the main recipient and adiscretionary fund of £30 kbe established to allow other local food distribution groups / organisations to apply for funding from the council to assist in delivery work within their respective communities."






